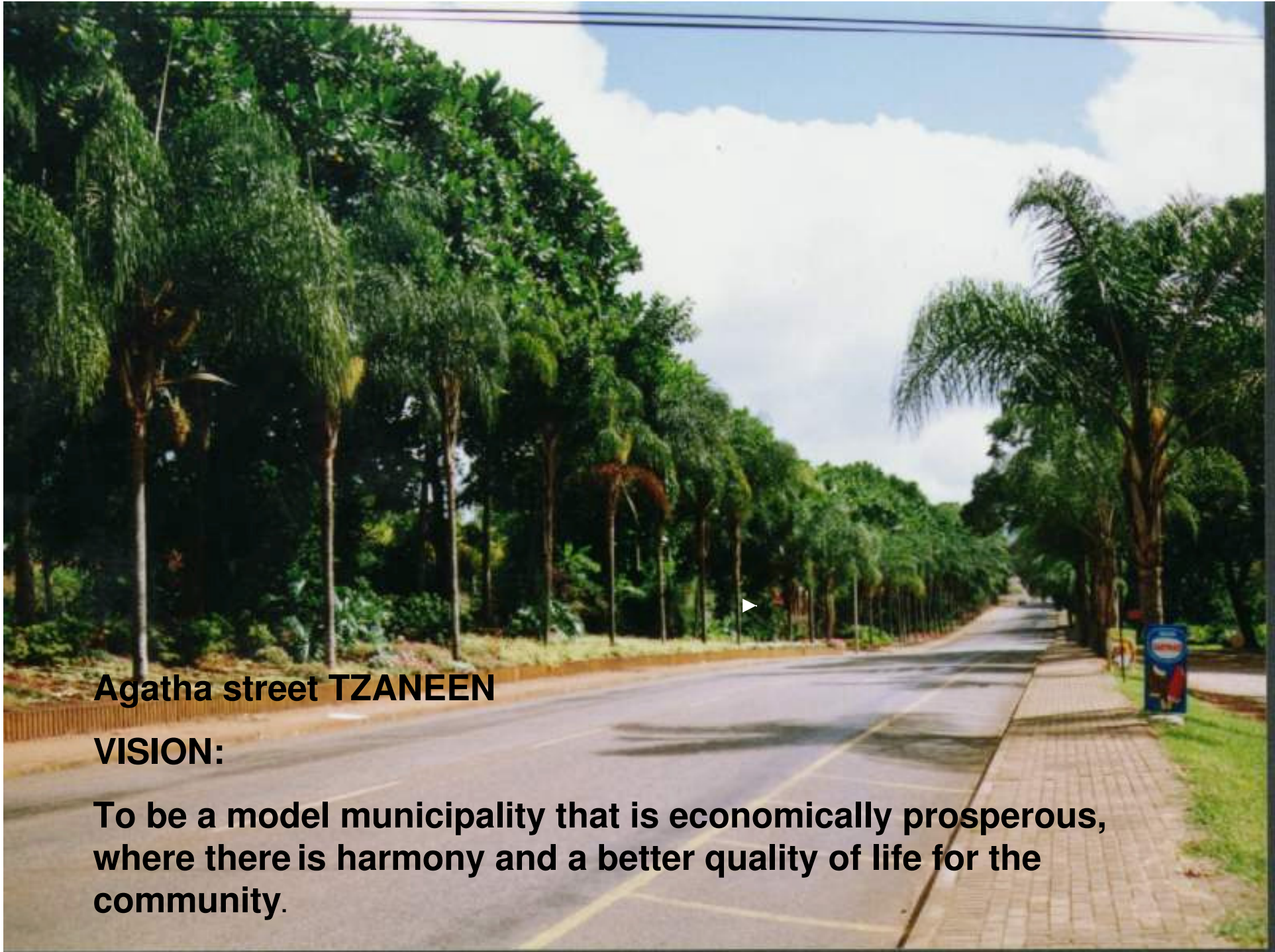

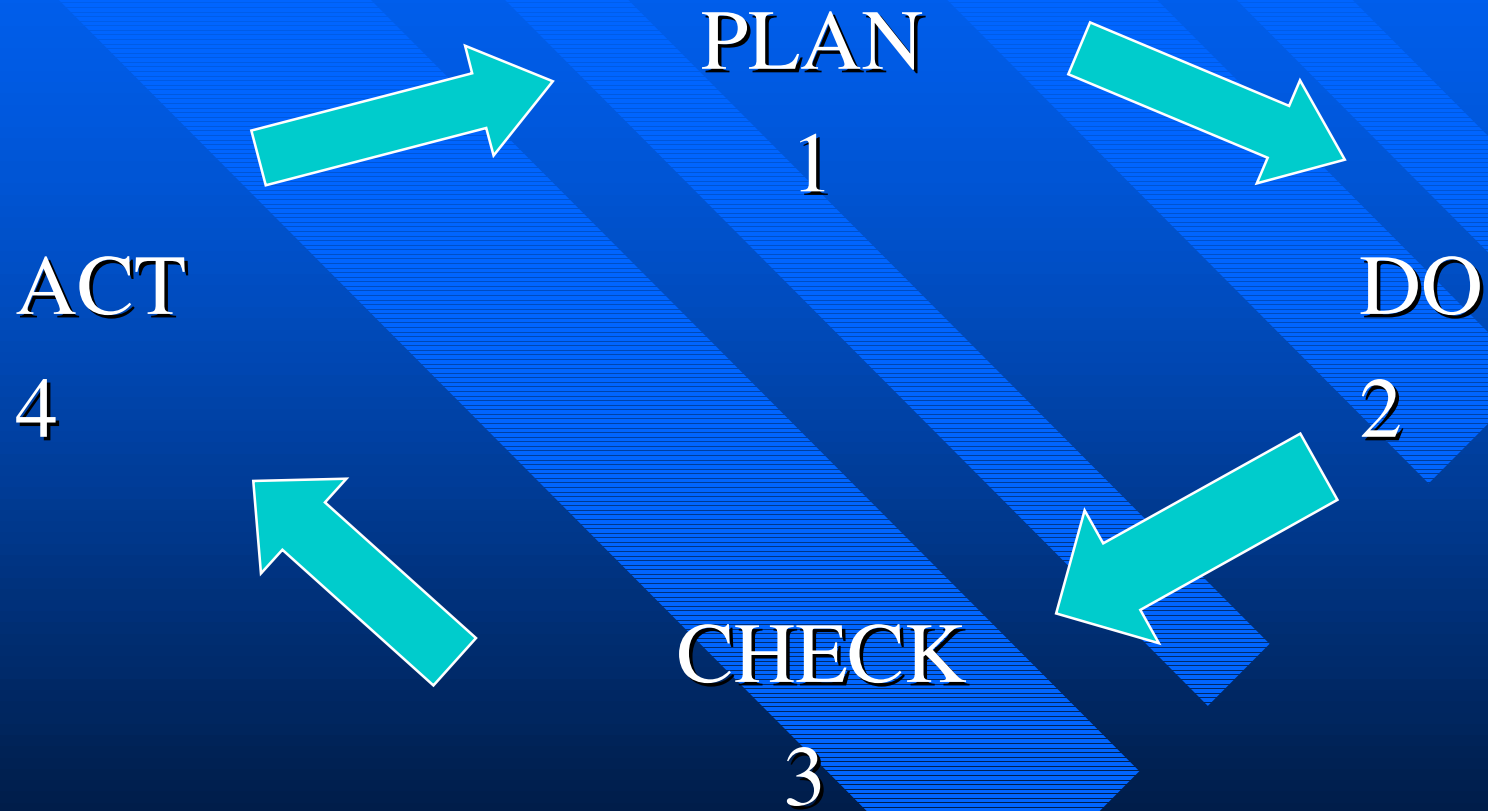
VISION:

- Hawkers also find storm water drains as a convenient dumping place
- The structures from which hawkers operated were unsightly





PLAN

- **IDENTIFICATION OF IMPACTS AND ASPECTS**
 - **Services: storm water management and informal sector development**
 - **Impact: water, land and visual pollution**
 - **Aspect: design of storm water inlets and badly constructed hawkers structures**

- Quotations were sought for screening devices
- An item prepared and served before council for approval
