-  It should be possible to enjoy the sweet, low hanging fruits by focusing on medium sized cities

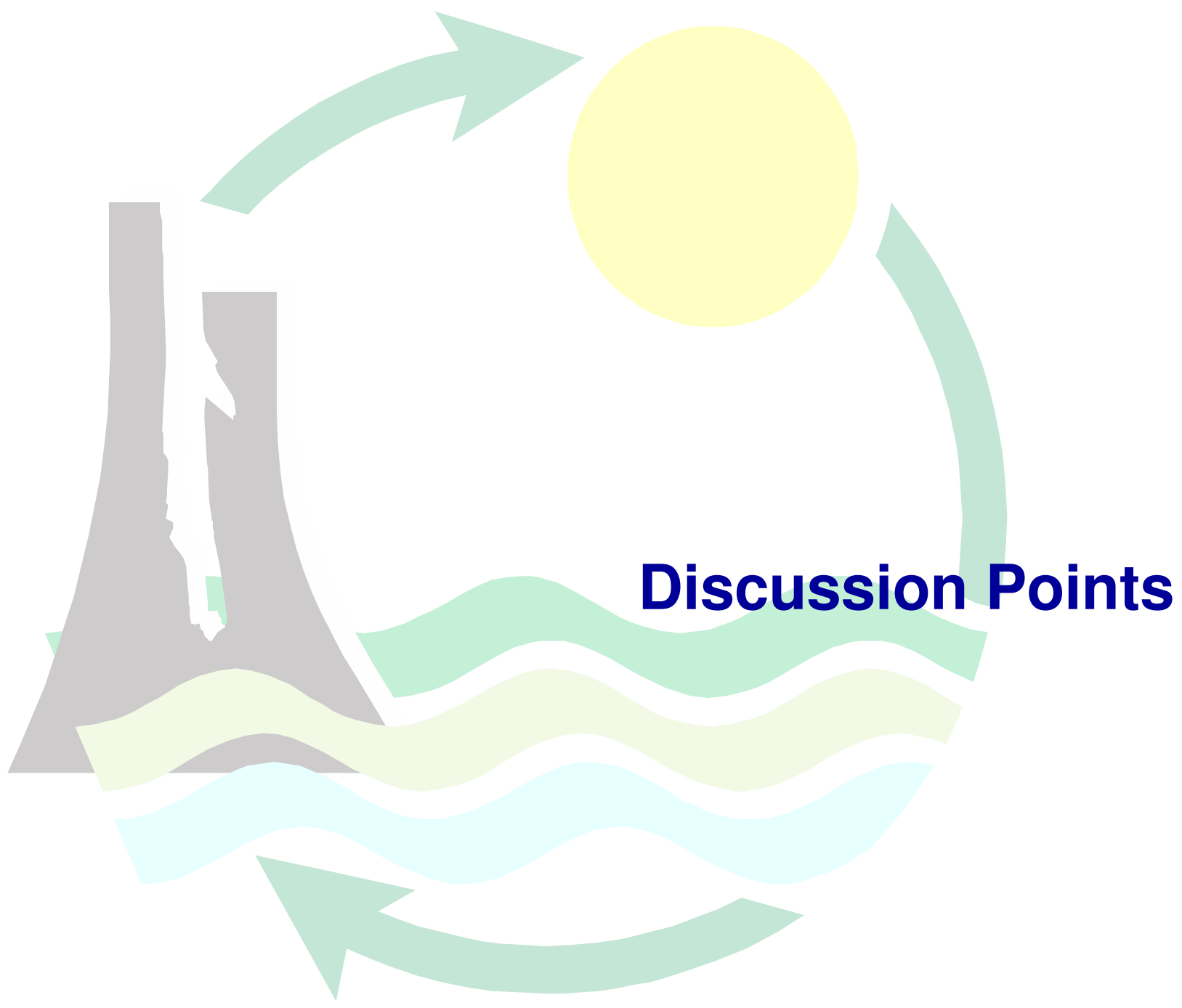
